1. Internet Safety

A reminder that next Tuesday (20th) we have organised a meeting for parents about Internet Safety. This will be led by David Wasley, an ex police officer who worked in the child safeguarding team. Could I urge you to attend if at all possible, whatever age your child is. The internet is a wonderful but potentially ever more dangerous place for young people, and it's really important for parents to be aware of these dangers and how to help their children avoid them. The meeting will start at 6.15pm and is likely to last for around an hour.

2. School Administrator

I am pleased to inform you that the Governors have appointed Mrs Vikki Novelle to the post of school administrator. Mrs Novelle is currently doing a similar job in a school in Crowthorne in Berkshire, she is relocating with her family to Cirencester in August. Mrs Novelle starts at Miserden in September but will be visiting a couple of times later this term to work with Mrs Williams.

3. Sponsored Silence and Non Uniform Day

The School Council has decided to organise a Sponsored Silence to raise money to support Senchura Kireu. Senchura lives in Kenya and for the past few years this school has raised funds to pay for his education. Our aim is to raise £300. The Sponsored Silence, (which will certainly be a challenge for me!) will be in school time during the morning of Friday June 30th. All children in both classes will participate in this and we will try to keep it going for an hour (whilst doing work at the same time of course!). If you would like to help your child to collect sponsors a form is attached with this letter. Please note that the amount to put on the form is for each 15 minutes of silence, up to a maximum of an hour. We realise some children might not manage an hour!

June 30th will also be a non uniform day to add to the Senchura pot, children to bring in £1 for the privilege of not wearing uniform.

4. Pirate Prince

All the children from Reception to Y6 will have a part in our end of term musical production 'The Pirate Prince'. There is one performance of this production, on Wednesday July 12th at 7pm. Please indicate on the slip below how many tickets you would like for the performance. Tickets are free, there will be a collection at the end to help our support for Senchura Kireu.

Information about costume requirements will be sent home in the next week or so. Generally children in Class 2 are pirates and Class 1 are parrots! The costumes will be quite simple and you shouldn't need to buy anything.
